

Dutch Craft Beer Conference 2023 Terms & Conditions

Terms & conditions participants of Dutch Craft Beer Conference 2023, organised by CRAFT.

1. Definitions

In these terms & conditions the following is meant by these terms:

- a. The event: Dutch Craft Beer Conference scheduled for March 22 and 23, 2023 in 's Hertogenbosch, Netherlands.
- b. The organization: CRAFT, which applies these terms and conditions.
- c. The participant: the natural or legal person who agrees to participate with the organization.
- d. Participation costs: all costs that the participant owes the organization in connection with his participation in the event.
- 2. Date, time schedule and accommodation
 - a. The dates and programs of the event as well as the accommodations of the events are determined by the organization.
 - b. The organization has the right to change the established date(s), schedule(s) and/or accommodation(s) of the event or to decide to cancel the event or to have the event take place entirely online, if in its opinion of the organization special circumstances justify such a decision.
 - c. The special circumstances in the previous paragraph are understood to mean; (market) conditions, any direct or indirect consequence of an event over which the organizer has no control, including but not limited to disease, epidemic, pandemic, strike, lockout, industrial breakdown [etc...] and all other circumstances according to the organization, after weighing up the interests, this could jeopardize the success of the event.
 - d. Under no circumstances can the participant claim any compensation from the organization for costs incurred or damage suffered in connection with a decision as referred to in paragraph b of this article.

3. Registration

- a. Registration for the event must be done by means of the appropriate registration form.
- b. The participant can pay the registration fee online immediately after completing the registration or choose to pay by invoice. In the latter case, the organization will send an invoice, which must be paid within 30 days of receipt and at least before the start of the event.
- c. The registration fees give access to the conference program and include catering (lunch, coffee and tea and drinks) for the on-site meetings.
- d. The organization reserves the right to refuse the registration request without stating reasons, even if a registration has been previously accepted.

4. Payment

- a. Payment of participation costs must be made within thirty days of the invoice date, unless a different due date is stated on the invoice.
- b. If payment of any amount due to the organization has not been made within the set term, the statutory interest will be due from the moment the amount has become due and payable. The collection costs are for the account of the participant, on the understanding that the extrajudicial collection costs are set at 15% of the principal sum.
- c. If the amount due is not (fully) credited to the account at the start of the event, the organization has the right to revoke the allocation already granted, after oral or written notice of default and notice of default.
- d. If participation is abandoned after it has been agreed and paid, the participant is not entitled to a refund of participation costs or part thereof.

5. Cancellation

- a. Cancellation must in all cases be made in writing.
- b. In case of written cancellation (e-mail) effective on the date received by the organization, the following deductions will be made. The organization will hold any deposit or cancellation deductions as described below.
 - a. until January 1, 2023: €50 cancellation fee
 - b. after January 1, 2023: no cancellation possible.
- c. No refunds will be made after January 1, 2023. No-show of CRAFT members on the day of the conference will be charged €50.
- d. If the participant cannot participate in the event due to special circumstances, the cancellation deductions will be examined in consultation with the organization.
- e. Ticket can be transferred to another participant, for this the change of name must be communicated before March 21, 2023.

6. Liability

- a. The organisation can in no sense be held responsible for damage to, or loss of any possessions of the participant, regardless of the event that caused the damage or loss.
- b. The participants shall take complete responsibility for compensating the costs of any loss or repair of damage, caused by his doing, to furniture or inventory of the accommodation of the event. The participants are responsible for taking appropriate insurance cover in connection with their travel to and attendance at the conference.
- c. The organisation shall not be liable, in any country or court of law, for infringement or third party rights by a participant of the conference.

7. Event recording and copyrights

a. By attending the event, participants acknowledge and agree that they can be recorded on photo and/or video, on-site during a live event and/or online during a virtual event. The organisation may edit and use footage it captures at the conference for marketing and promotional activities and for any other purpose in the ordinary course of its business.

The organisation reserves the right to amend, add or remove any of the above Terms and Conditions or the content of the website in its sole discretion, at any time without prior notice. The Terms and Conditions apply to all event participants.

The organisation will decide in all cases in which this code of practice does not provide
